AWARD PRESENTATIONS

FLIFF continues the 38-year tradition of honoring noteworthy filmmakers and actors during the festival. A video montage of each honoree's career will be shown prior to the award presentations. The honorees are:

Robert Schwartzman, director of *The Good Half*, will receive the Renaissance Award on Opening Night, Friday, November 3 at 7pm at Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Hollywood. Robert also wrote much of the score for the film and performed it with his band Rooney. He co-stars opposite Anne Hathaway in *The Princess Diaries*, which will be screened free for all children on Saturday November 4 at Savor Cinema. Later that evening at 7pm, FLIFF presents *Hung Up On a Dream*, the documentary he directed about the '60s musical group The Zombies. And on Friday, November 10 at 8pm the comedy *Drugstore June*, produced by Robert, will be shown at Savor Cinema.

David Arquette (*Scream*), **Matt Walsh** (*The Hangover, VEEP*), and **Brittany Snow** (*Hairspray, Pitch Perfect*) will each receive the **Career Achievement Award** on Opening Night on November 3. *Parachute*, Brittany's directorial debut, screens November 4 at 7pm at Savor Cinema. All three have major roles in *The Good Half*, the Opening Night film.

Now in its 38th year, the <u>Fort Lauderdale International Film Festival</u> (FLIFF), November 3 through November 16, will showcase nearly 200 films from 40 countries, featuring **eight world premieres and six U.S. premieres.** The festival includes features, documentaries and short film programs, along with **Filmed in Broward**, a showcase of 21 films by South Florida filmmakers, all filmed in Broward County, www.fliff.com
