On Tuesday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, the Fort Lauderdale International Film Festival (FLIFF) will unveil the official poster image for the upcoming 39<sup>th</sup> annual festival taking place November 8 – 17. The festive event will kick off at 6PM at Savor Cinema, 503 SE 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale.

This year's poster features the artwork of internationally renowned artist **Guy Harvey**, who incorporated his recognizable marine wildlife imagery into an image created by Carlos Suarez, publisher of Venice Magazine. Without disclosing too much prior to the great reveal, the result of this unique collaboration is an iconic representation of Florida's sea life and the film industry.

In addition to the poster unveiling, the evening will include a preview of films that will screen at the film festival in November, along with live music, open bar and scrumptious light bites provided by The Boatyard and Southport Raw Bar.
